

## PROTECTIVE COVERALLS (TAPED)

### Zipper and Velcro

It has two-way zipper allowing a comfortable use. Additional velcro covering the zipper is available for more protection.

### Protective Hood

Leakage through the head is prevented by elasticated band on the hood.

### Extra Protective Tape

All seams are taped for extra protection .

### Elastic Waistband

It has elastic band on the waistline for more comfortable and free movement.

### Elastic Wrist & Ankle Protective

It prevents leakages through the elastic bands on ankle and wrist.

### Fabric Material

Laminated fabric offering a barrier quality against several low concentrated inorganic chemicals and particulates.
